

## **In-Year Application at Pimlico Primary**

An In-Year Application is when you need to make an application to a school outside of the normal admissions round. You would normally be making an in year application if you recently moved, you have arrived from another country or you want to transfer your child to another school.

Parents or guardians, who would like to make an in-year application for a place at Pimlico Primary, will need to apply to their home Borough Council. If you are a resident of Westminster or the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea, you should apply using the Bi-Borough In-Year Application form. The quickest and easiest way to apply is online. You can also apply by post.

Once your application has been received by the Bi-Borough Admissions Team, it will be processed and then sent to Pimlico Primary for a decision as to whether a place can be offered. Please note that the processing stage can take a minimum of up to 10 working days.

If we are able to offer your child a place, we will contact you via the telephone number or email address that you provided on your application form.
