We cannot believe it is already our last term together. This term, we will focus on preparing the children for Year 1. As part of this transition, the children will have the opportunity to meet their new Year 1 teacher and spend time in their new classroom.

English

This term, we are going to be creating our own stories! By the end of the term, the children are expected to be able to make up their own stories, with a clear beginning, middle and end and using story language. We will begin by looking at *Hansel and Gretel* by the Brothers Grimm to inspire our own fairy tales. At this stage in the year, the expectation is that children can read and write simple sentences independently, which can be read by themselves and others. Children must be able to do this to meet the end of year expectation.

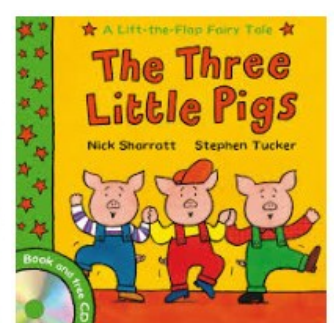
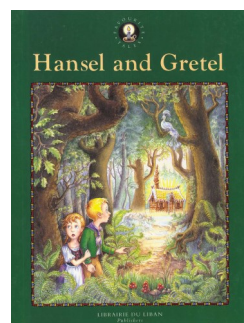

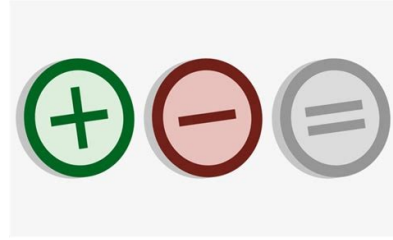
Summer weather

Maths

This term, our Maths Mastery units are:

- Addition and subtraction of single numbers within 20
- Measurement
- Greater depth of numbers within 20



For children to meet the end of year expectation for Maths, they need to be able to count reliably within 20, place them in order and say one more and one fewer. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Key vocab: addition, subtractions, add, take away, plus, is equal to, length, width, height, weight, longer, shorter, heavier, lighter, bigger/biggest, smaller/smallest

Activities at home:

- Recognition of numbers to 20
- Addition and subtraction of single digit numbers within 20
- Finding one more and one fewer within 20
- Looking for shapes in the environment
- Comparing measurements
- Measuring objects using random objects. For example, the plate is 10 paperclips long.

PE

Please remember your child should come to school on a Wednesday wearing their PE kit. This term, we are focusing on group relay games.

History

This term, we will be learning about British monarchs, past and present, and the significance of crowns. As part of this learning, we will be having a Royals Day in school (more information to follow).

Key vocab: crown, jewels, king, queen, past, present, William the Conqueror, Henry VIII, Elizabeth II.



Science

This term, we will learn about the life cycles of animals. We will even have caterpillars in our classroom!

Key vocab: caterpillar, cocoon, chrysalis, butterfly, life cycle
